# IMPACT STORY **MONGOLIA**

Gombojav and I did not understand each other. **There was no love in our marriage. I was successful, proud and busy.** I didn't take time to care for my son or my husband. But I was very discouraged, so I would go out and get drunk.

One night, after a fight, my husband drove away. He came home very late. He told me about a testimony he heard on radio. It was about how a man's life had changed, and he said, maybe our lives can change too.

I said to him, I want to change my life. He said, 'yes, your life can be changed if you believe in Jesus truly.' I decided to follow Jesus. Now, I serve the church made up of all the people who received Jesus through the radio program.

There was a Darkness in my life. I visited all the best lamas and shamans to help my life change, but nothing helped. And I'd cry. I'd want to die. Dashdorj, my wife, was also a drunk. And she always said, 'I regret that I married you.' I tried to commit suicide, several times.

I had tried other religions. But they did not help me. Jesus is real. Now, I feel an ease in my heart, and I know that God is with me and protecting my beloved wife.

Before I was a person who could not smile and laugh. Now, I'm very happy. I was in sorrow, but now I have peace.




Gombojav, Listener

# IMPACT NEWS **UKRAINE**

We thank and praise God for a great start to 2024 with this miracle.

FEBC-Ukraine was able to secure a permanent, 10-year licence to broadcast on 89.4 FM in Kyiv, the capital of Ukraine.

After broadcasting under a special war provisional licence for about a year-and-a-half, we applied for a permanent licence. We were hoping against hope to receive a 7-year licence. Several business groups were looking to get that frequency. Miraculously, we were able to secure the licence, and the government issued it to us for 10 years instead of 7.

As we were preparing for our presentation to the government body that issues frequencies, we gathered written and video testimonies of the impact FEBC is having on Ukrainian society. In Ukraine, this is an open process, broadcast live to anyone and everyone to see how the decision is made.

One after another, listeners and experts related the stories of families being reunited, marriages being saved, and suicides being averted. Soldiers were restored to some sense of normalcy as they listened to FEBC after returning from the battlefield. Some committee members could not hold back tears as they saw the impact of the Gospel on the people of Ukraine.

FEBC's station in Kyiv is especially effective, as is evident by the response we are seeing. Almost a quarter of all responses we receive in Ukraine come from the Kyiv region. Here's what listeners are saying:

- Most Ukrainians are grateful for the opportunity to hear a clear, simple, and relevant presentation of the Gospel. People appreciate the way our broadcasters, who are living in the same life-threatening situations, talk about their hope and faith in Jesus Christ. The most often repeated phrase is "I never thought that I could actually approach God and become His daughter..."
- Many are asking for help with and prayer for their family situation. Millions of families in Ukraine have been separated, and many families have ended up in divorce. We have specially-trained people who help listeners save or restore their families and find salvation in Jesus in the process.
- Many children are calling for comfort, and many are calling to ask questions about God. Many are becoming "friends of Jesus" as a result of these conversations.
- Young teens are calling us for help. They are desperate for love and peace, with many being suicidal. We help hundreds and lead them to Jesus.

Thank you, Australia, for your generosity. May God bless you for your continued support and prayer over many years. The team continues to serve amidst the challenges of war and would value your prayers as we near the 2nd anniversary of the invasion.


#### Sources of income - FEBC FY 2023

FEBC Australia's main income source was donations (85%, tax deductible and non-tax deductible) from individuals, churches and groups; and bequests (10%).

Thanks to our long-term faithful supporters and increasing number of new supporters, the total monetary donations excluding bequests was \$1,894,195 (5% less than last year, which was our highest donation income achieved over the last decade).

Income from bequests also significantly supports our strategy of committing to projects over multi-years instead of yearly committments.











#### **Funds disbursement by country**







#### The joy of meeting Margaret

Margaret was 101 years old when we met her in March 2023. What caught our attention was her eloquence, energy, and a wonderful memory. Her positive attitude to life despite life's ups and downs comes from a deep longing for God and a faith that has stood the test of time over many decades. We thank God for the opportunity to hear her story but also learn from her wisdom.

Margaret was born in February 1922, in Ballarat, Victoria. The family then moved to Melbourne for a few years before moving to Sydney in 1928.

She has lived through the Great Depression, the Second World War, the Vietnam war, the collapse of the Soviet Union, the Sydney Olympics, 9/11, and events in recent years including the pandemic which impacted all of us.

Margaret's mother was a woman of faith and a strong influence in her life. **She attributes her mum's prayers for shaping her faith and acceptance of Jesus as her Saviour.** She says the relationship with Jesus is a growing process through life's battles and by learning more about Him each day.

We asked Margaret if she was lonely, and she was quick to say 'No', citing her endearing relationship with Jesus and God's word, which keeps her busy and rooted in faith. She jokes about not finding the right guy when asked if she was ever married.

Some key events and milestones that are etched in Margaret's memory are the loss of her brother in a swimming accident in 1952 when he was only 26 years old and her dad's sudden death in 1962 due to a heart attack. Her mother passed away two years after dad, and she recalls the very difficult decision to put her in a nursing home for better care. She thinks her parents would have lived longer if they had had the same care and medical advancements that are available today.

What Margaret likes about FEBC is our ability to share God's word through radio in places where people have no knowledge of God. As a listener of radio herself, she is empathetic about people hearing God's voice through His word on radio. She believes God's word changes lives just as it has changed hers.

You will hear more about Margaret in other publications this year. We thank God for her life and generosity. We continue to pray for her good health and long life.

The FEBC team continues to work on **improving donor engagement and partnerships**. Simultaneously, we are **inspiring more people** (especially those in a younger demographic) across Australia to **partner in God's mission** through FEBC.
