Southeast Asia 1-9 Jan

1 "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." (Jeremiah 29:11)

2 Praise God for the five new Cambodia Community Bible Institute (CCBI) audio Bible classes in Kampong Speu and Kampong Chnang provinces.

3 Pray for the many families still recovering from floods in Southeast Asia. Pray they find hope in Jesus.

4 Praise God! FEBC Indonesia helped 120 families in Padang and Aceh affected by the floods.

5 Pray for Myanmar: families have lost homes and villages from military junta attacks. Ask God to make a way for their return, and for our Partner's media broadcasts to bring His comfort.

6 "Your broadcasts have led many to Jesus. We're growing stronger in faith through these programs." – Listener, Southeast Asia

7 Pray for our Partner working with the Deaf in Vietnam to persevere in seeing lives touched and transformed. Pray for God's wisdom and protection.

8 Philippines: Praise God for fresh strategy focusing on people, partnerships, programming and processes. Pray for the team to serve communities better as they roll out these new approaches.

9 Pray for the unreached Blang. Population: 121,400*. Language: Blang. Religion: Buddhism.

International 10-18 Jan

10 Thank God for the thousands finding Jesus through Christmas programs!

11 Pray for both new believers and those exploring faith as FEBC teams walk with them.

12 After decades of ministry, many teams need updated workspaces—some for safety reasons. Please pray for God's provision.

13 As persecution continues to spread and increase in severity, please continue to pray for wisdom and protection for FEBC teams.

14 Pray for FEBC's media to bring comfort and community to secret believers, and to penetrate barriers to reach those searching for hope in areas where missionaries cannot physically go.

15 Praise God for FEBC teams using AI technology

wisely—for example, to share testimonies—keeping video stories safe while protecting identities.

16 Praise God for keeping local teams and the entire FEBC family united.

17 Praise God for keeping the faith and passion of FEBC teams for His mission.

18 Ask God to help us keep close to Him, close to listeners, and close to one another.

Australia 19-27 Jan

19 We're so thankful for you! Your generosity and passion inspire us. Praise God for uniting us with one heart: to reach the least reached with His gospel.

20 Thank God for the privilege of sharing His love in heart languages to the least reached through media.

21 May God continue to develop FEBC Australia as a God-centred organisation, pursuing first God and His heart, and aligning with His purpose.

22 Thank God for deepening relationships with our in-country Partners.

23 Ask for God's wisdom to reach and mobilise the younger generation for missions with us.

24 Ask God to continue to help us convey His love and care to you, our supporters and friends in our shared mission.

25 Pray for God's strategy to strengthen fundraising and expand our outreach.

26 On Australia Day, we thank God for this land and the resources He's given us. May we honour and uphold what He values.

27 Praise God for helping us stay committed to sharing the love of Christ in areas of persecution, conflict, and to those living with disabilities.

Central Asia 28 Jan-5 Feb

28 Kyrgyzstan: Pray for unity among the churches. May the Lord strengthen believers, protect them from persecution, and grant them spiritual growth.

29 In Kyrgyzstan, laws now prevent small religious groups from gathering unless they have 500 members. Pray that our Partner's media will reach those unable to meet in person.

30 Kazakhstan: Praise God for the new partnership with a network of churches.

31 Kazakhstan: Pray for wisdom to share Jesus' love where His message meets strong resistance.

"Your broadcast I find most interesting. You talk about God very differently. All I have heard so far in our religion is to be scared of God. According to you, God is our friend and saves us from sin and evil."

1 In Kazakhstan, evangelism outside church is illegal, and new believers face hostility. Pray for wisdom for our team as they build relationships, and ask God to open new doors for the gospel.

2 Mongolia: Pray for the listeners of programs for children with Down Syndrome and Autism. May they experience God's love for them.

3 Thank God for answered prayer! The Mongolian team remains united, healthy, and is growing spiritually. Pray the same for their families.

4 Mongolia: Praise God that the *Kids Time* program, which has transformed communication between parents and children in many families, recently won an award for the best family program.

5 Pray for the unreached Azerbaijani. Worldwide Population: 9,228,800*. Languages: North Azerbaijani. Religion: Islam

Middle East 6-14 Feb

6 Praise God! Our Partner's new team member in Iraq has finished technical training and is learning to produce programs. Pray he grows in skill and confidence to share Jesus, and that he blesses both the team and listeners through this ministry.

7 Pray for the new program 'Encounter with Hope' to help listeners understand that an encounter with Jesus is transformational, leading to eternal life.

8 Iraq: Praise God for listeners asking for Bibles. Pray for wisdom to discern genuine requests, as follow-ups can be risky in places of persecution.

9 Pray for our Yemeni Partner's program as it addresses community needs through Facebook and live discussions. May God use it to bring hope, healing, and open hearts to the gospel.

10 Praise God that our Partner's programs—on-air, online, and on social media—can reach up to 30 million Yemeni Arabic speakers. We ask the Holy Spirit to move through them to touch many hearts.

11 Pray for our Yemeni Partner as they follow up with and disciple listeners through social messaging platforms and Discovery Bible Study groups.

12 Praise God that through our in-country Partner's radio program, a young Yemeni listener found freedom by forgiving his uncle. Pray he also discovers the deeper freedom of knowing Jesus.

13 World Radio Day: Praise God for radio, a powerful tool to share His Word in remote and hostile places, and for reaching illiterate listeners too.

14 Pray for the unreached Middle-eastern Turkmen. Population: 4,903,000*. Language: Turkish, South

Azerbaijani. Religion: Islam.

East Asia & Chinese Ministries^ 15-23 Feb

15 Pray for Jesus' love to comfort those still grieving from the recent Hong Kong fires.

16 Pray for ethnic Koreans in the Korean Peninsula to receive the hope and peace that Jesus gives.

17 Ethnic Chinese celebrate Chinese New Year from today with visits to family and friends. Pray for God to open conversations for believers to share about His Good News.

18 Lent begins today. As we reflect on Jesus' trials and ministry, may our hearts be moved to reach the least reached who have yet to hear of His sacrifice and resurrection.

Listener, Iraq

19 Pray for Chinese-speaking believers worldwide to discover and share FEBC's Chinese Ministry's online broadcasts and resources.

20 Pray for believers in this East Asian country to have courage to stand firm in their faith, and wisdom to navigate tighter controls on religious groups.

21 International Mother Language Day: Praise God for local FEBC teams worldwide sharing the gospel in heart languages. Pray for expansion beyond 154 languages.

22 Pray for God to encourage and grow the FEBC team in Japan, a country where 98.2%* of its population remains unreached.

23 Pray for God to open the eyes of the people across East Asia, to see Jesus not as a Western God but one linked to their ancestry and origin.

Eurasia 24 Feb-4 Mar

24 Four years into the Ukraine war, many are suffering and weary. Pray for God's strength to sustain the FEBC Ukraine team as they continue reaching people amid their own struggles of losing loved ones or having loved ones drafted.

25 Ukraine: Praise God for two new male counsellors – former soldiers, who are able to add their experience to the largely female team.

26 Praise God! Young Ukrainians are finding healing from trauma, depression, and suicidal thoughts through FEBC Ukraine's counselling support.

27 Counselling needs from soldiers increase after their return as they grapple with PTSD, fear, anger and violence. Pray for FEBC Ukraine's trained counsellors guiding people to Jesus' peace.

28 Continue to pray for peace in this region and God's healing for all who are suffering in the war.

^ Prayer points in this region refer to the work of the broader FEBC Association, and may be in response to their prayer requests.

1 Moldova: Praise God for partnerships with Christian vloggers. One has a 50,000-viewer following and broadcasts in Romanian.

2 Pray for our FEBC Moldova team supporting youth in poverty or broken families, that they find comfort in God as their heavenly Father through weekly meetings and online connections.

"I've begun to realize that Christianity is about more than just following rules. It's about having a relationship with Jesus."

3 Praise God for our new children's Christian songs that are also popular with pre-believing children at children's events.

4 Pray for the unreached Gorani. Worldwide population: 53,000*. Language: Serbian, Macedonian. Religion: Islam.

Ethnic Ministry (Southeast Asia) 5-13 Mar

5 Thank God for all 22 language broadcasts running, including our Rawang ministry, despite electricity shortage, military coup, civil wars, internet instability, and other challenges.

6 Praise God! First Kamphthi language broadcast launched! FEBC Ethnic Ministry's broadcaster is reaching out to his own people across Burmese villages via radios. Pray for safety and open hearts.

7 Praise God for the six Mon and other migrants in a Southeast Asian country that have accepted Jesus as their Lord and Saviour and been baptised.

8 Pray for God to provide the land and buildings needed as Ethnic Ministry grows

9 Praise God for the gathering that greatly encouraged 366 Hmong listeners from four different Southeast Asian countries.

10 Thank you for staying committed with us to share God's love amongst some of the most persecuted people in Southeast Asia. Pray for God's strength for persecuted believers to stay in faith.

11 Praise God for the Mien youth camp where 287 attended and 20 gave their lives to Jesus. Pray for God to encourage the 100 who could not attend due to restrictions.

12 Praise God that a listener was delivered from evil spirits just by listening to an FEBC broadcast.

13 Pray for the unreached Aheu Luang. Population: 2,300*. Language: Aheu. Religion: Buddhism.

South Asia 14-22 Mar

14 Pray for wisdom and protection as our Partner in a South Asian country shares Jesus' love in areas where there are many (and increasing) restrictions.

15 Pray for the safety of our in-country Partner as they visit listeners in remote areas of a South Asian country with increasing persecution.

16 Praise God our church partner survived an attack in a South Asian country. Pray for complete healing of her knees.

17 Pray that Portable Life Changers—speaker boxes given to those in extreme poverty or remote areas in this South Asian country—bring the hope of Christ through our programs.

18 Pakistan: Pray for a new office in a safe location, as the old one is no longer safe.

19 Pray for greater reach into remote, underserved and hard-to-reach communities in Pakistan.

20 Pray more people find Jesus, like this Pakistani listener: "Your programs bring amazing, personal teaching that has touched us since last year."

21 Praise God that the listenership for our local Partner's community radio station has doubled and listeners are sharing their prayer requests.

22 Pray for the unreached Aghori. Population: 71,000*. Language: Hindi. Religion: Hinduism.

Africa 23-31 Mar

23 Kenya: Praise God for the 78,000 phone calls and 10,000 social media comments the team had with audiences in early 2025.

24 Kenya: Pray for our Partner, receiving coaching in crafting content for community listener meetings.

25 Kenya: Pray for strategies to follow up on critical stories and community feedback.

26 Praise God! After a year of advocacy through radio, families displaced due to last year's floods in Tana River, Kenya, have finally been allocated land for them to rebuild safer, permanent homes.

27 North Kivu, Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC): As armed violence continues, pray for peace and for our Partner to bring Christ's healing through media to those suffering.

28 Praise God our Partner in North Kivu, DRC became the heartbeat of recovery from a devastating massacre, bringing the peace and healing of Jesus to the community.

29 Palm Sunday. 'Hosanna!' or 'Save, please!' May our Easter outreaches through media around the world let all hear about Jesus, our Saviour King.

30 North Kivu (DRC): Pray for the joy of the Lord to strengthen our Partner as they broadcast amid challenging and life-threatening circumstances.

31 Pray for the unreached Khasonke. Population: 1,094,800*. Language: Xaasongaxango. Religion: Islam.
